Punica granatum

Cultivation:

- Drought tolerant
- Excel in desert alkaline soil
- Full sun to part shade
- Zones 7 - 11

Blooms:

Late winter through early spring

Fruits:

August and September

Health Benefits:

- Reduces cellular damage
- Supports joint health
- Inhibits cancer cell proliferation
- Prevents inflammation
